Happy May Day!

Fruits and vegetables can be harmful as well. Apple seeds, most pits of any fruit, plums, apricots, avocadoes, grapes, prunes, raisins, wild cherries, mushrooms, almonds, macadamia nuts, walnuts, onions, and garlic.

Now that spring has really sprung, here is a list of flowers and plants that are toxic to dogs.

Flowers and plants that cause rashes: Cactus, Chrysanthemums, Ficus, Poison Ivy, Oak, Sumac, Pothos Ivy, Primrose, and Scheifflera.

Flowers and plants that cause upset stomachs, vomiting, diarrhea, and gas: Amaryllis, Baby's Breath, Carnations, Clematis, Daffodil, Freesia, Holly, Hydrangeas, Peonies, Poinsettia, Scheifflera, Aster, Boxwood, Cala Lilies, Chrysanthemums, Cyclamen, English Ivy, Gladiolas, Hyacinth, Kalanchoe, Morning Glories, Pothos Ivy, and Tulips.

Flowers that cause organ damage:
Azalea, Crocus, Foxglove, and Juniper.

Flowers that cause death:

Agapanthus, Azalea, Cyclamen, Delphinium, Dumb Cane, Foxglove, Lantana, Larkspur, Mistletoe, Oleander, Rhododendron, and Sago Palms.

If you suspect your dog has ingested something harmful, call your vet immediately.
