Military Dogs



Dogs were actively recruited to work in the trenches, about 10,000 of them. Many of the WWII dogs made it home, but in the Vietnam War, dogs were considered equipment and left behind. In 2000, President Clinton signed a bill that allowed military dogs to come home to be adopted. Some military dogs see many tours and have different handlers. Even though they can be adopted, there is a large cost in doing so. There are many non-profit organizations to help both veterans and dogs.

There is also a great influx of military dog books on the market today, so you can learn more about our amazing K9 heroes. Here are just a few of the newest.






<u>Trident K9 Warriors</u>, by Mike Ritland and Gary Brozek
