

Meet Blitz, a Search and Rescue Dog in Training.

Beth Sullivan has been bringing her dog Blitz to D Tails' Drop-In Obedience classes since he was just a pup. Blitz, now almost two, has grown into a handsome, wellbehaved German Shephard. This summer, Blitz received his Canine Good Citizen and his Therapy dog credentials. But that's not all; for the past 18 months, Blitz and Beth, have been training for search and rescue. This has taken many hours and complete dedication! Beth and Blitz drive to upstate NY on Sundays for the specialized training. This training can take about two years to complete! They are training with a volunteer search and rescue organization that uses air-scenting German Shepherd Dogs to locate missing persons in the wilderness or disaster situations. Because Beth is Blitz's handler, she is getting trained as well. The pair have had first responder medical training, K9 medical training, and map, compass, and GPS navigation training. Right now, Blitz is learning live rescues using human scent. They search in various situations too, including wilderness, urban, disaster, water, crime scene, and cadaver and evidence recovery. Next up for Beth and Blitz is cadaver detection! Beth agrees that this takes a lot of time and hard work, but she is motivated by the possibility of one day Blitz using all of his training to locate someone.








Dog Lover's Gift Guide




Renowned artist and author Maira Kalman's book about her beloved dog, Pete, and other dogs who have touched her life.

Max didn't last long at the box office, but it still received decent reviews. It's a heartwarming story that will bring tears and laughter. Rated PG.






Famous on Instagram and now in a book! Photographer, Elias Weiss Friedman's encounters with 1000 dogs! All adorable too!
