If you stay home, entertain your dog with a special bone and lots of love!


Donna and Beth's Excellent Adventure to Canine Camp Getaway!




All that fun and hard work made Blitz exhausted!

The dogs are shown items with the rat's scent, those items are hidden in a hay bale maze. Once the dogs find the items with the scent, they move up to actually locating the rat. (The rats are safely ensconced in protective tubes the dogs cannot break.)The challenges in locating the rat continue to increase in difficulty. Yes, the rats are real, but no, they are not harmed.
