Here are some interesting facts about Westminster. It was started around 1876 in New York City by a group of gentlemen who would congregate after a day of hunting with their Pointers. They met in the Westminster Hotel and that's where they took their name. In 1877, they held a show in Philadelphia and officially became a club and changed their name to the Westminster Kennel Club. They held a show in NYC, at the Hippodrome (later to become Madison Square Garden.) They were such a hit, they stayed open for 4 days! The first Best in Show was in 1907, and it was a smooth Fox Terrier. Over the years, there have been 18 BIS Fox terriers-wire and smooth! The next breed with the most BIS wins is the Scottish Terrier. Overall, the terrier group has had the most wins. No type of retriever has ever won. Here is the official trailer from the 2000 movie Best in Show. It's truly funny and has a great ensemble cast!


