Signs of Heatstroke

Excessive panting with increased sticky saliva -lips often pulled back with mouth WIDE open (can see right down throat)

Bright red tongue with red or pale gums

Altered mental state- can be frantic, depressed

Unresponsive- can lead to coma

Weakness/dizziness

Increased heart rate

Vomiting- sometimes with blood

Diarrhea










New faces at D Tails






