

Wednesday:


Nosework I, 6:00-7:00 pm. Classes on October 3, 10, 24, 31. There is no class on October 17.


Have you seen Brett Eldridge's new video for his song "Love Someone?" The someone is his dog, Edgar, and it is very sweet! You can watch it here:
