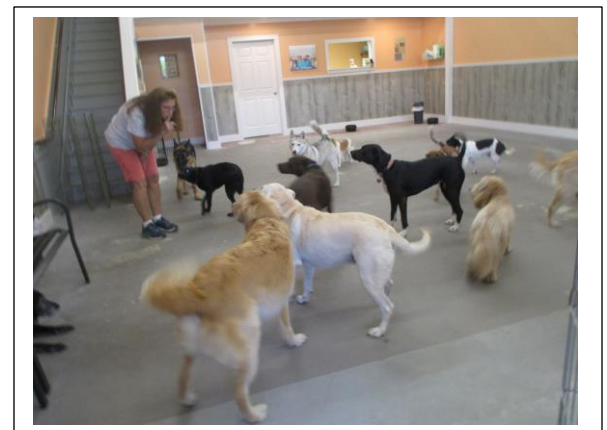
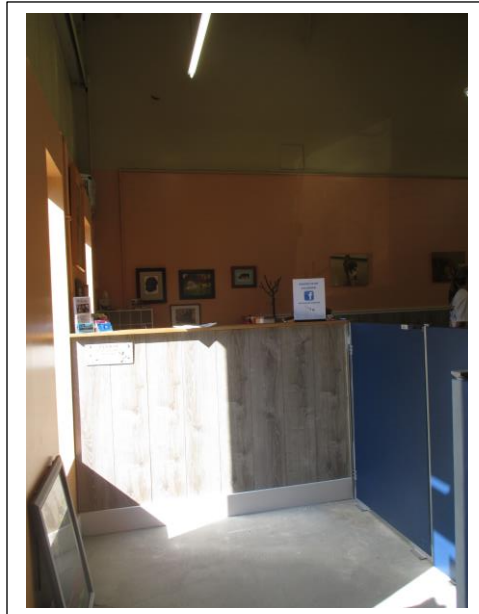
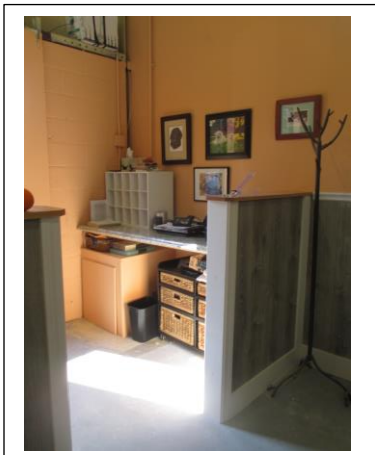
#### Thursday: \*\*\*NEW CLASS\*\*\*
