If you see a dog that is tied out in this weather for more than 15 minutes, please call your local animal control or police department. Even though dogs have an excellent sense of smell and direction, they can become disoriented in a lot of snow. Be mindful of any body of water that you perceive as frozen. With our up and down temps, it might not be completely frozen. There have already been several dogs rescued from frozen ponds in the news. Do not forget to protect their paws! Booties or salve, like Musher's secret, will protect from frostbite and ice balls. Also, if you are struggling with caring for your pet during this pandemic, please reach out for help. Please do not dump your dog. If you can help a dog in need, Lincoln is being cared for by Dan Cosgrove Animal Shelter. He was found in the morning, shivering with frostbite and other medical issues. 
# **Heads and Tails**




