Handling, 6:00-7:00 pm. No Class on August 24. See calendar for individual instructors.

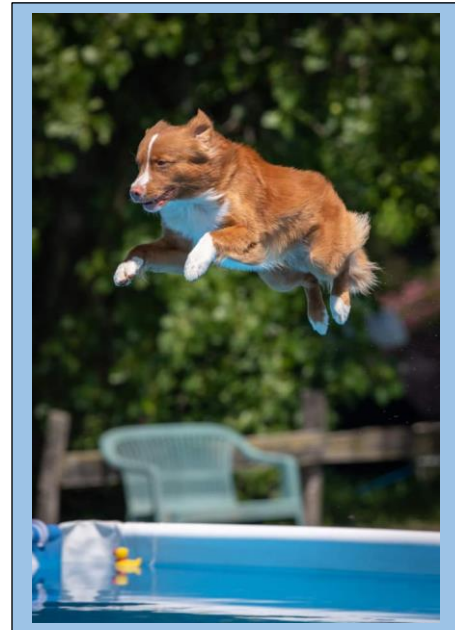
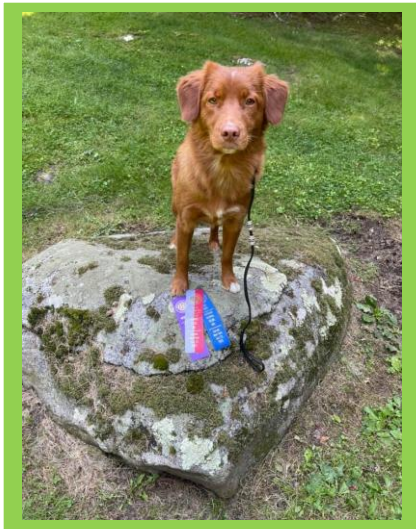

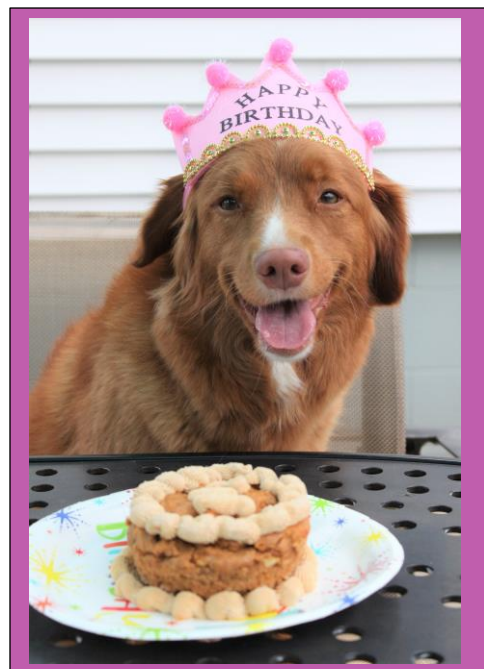
