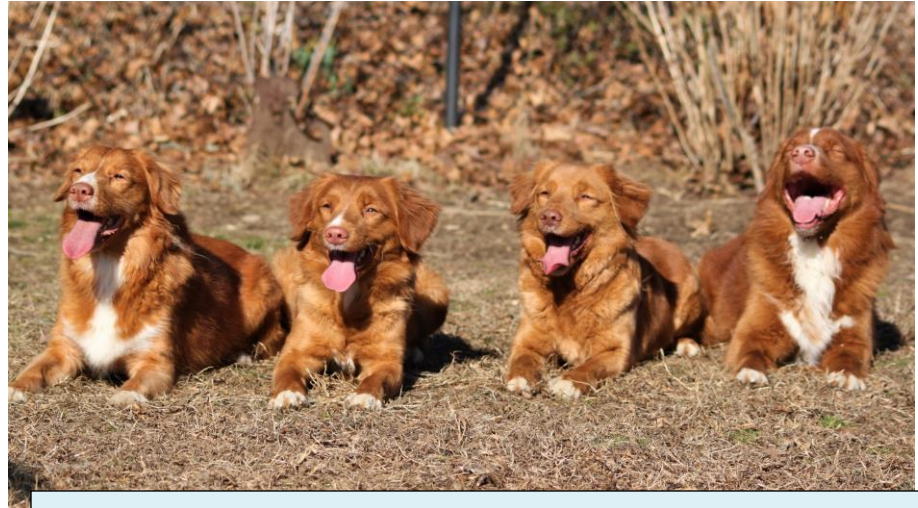

Beginner Obedience, 6:00-7:00 pm.

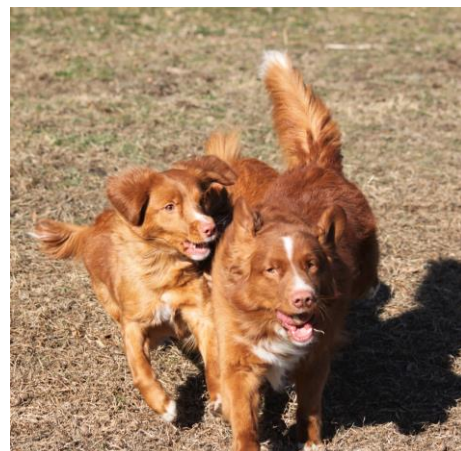

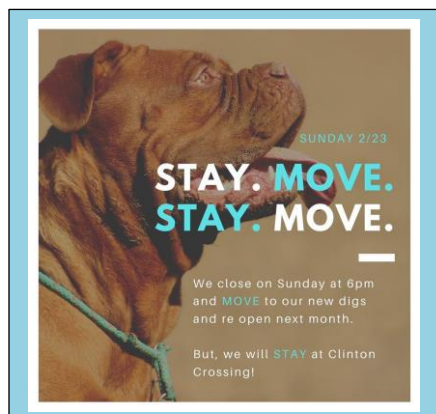
